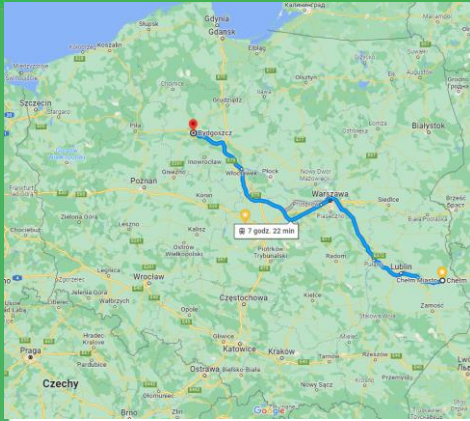

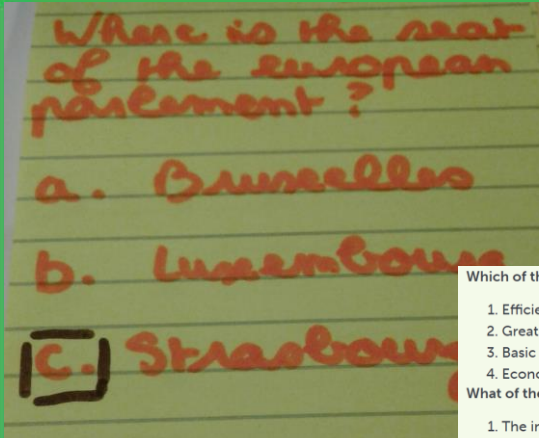

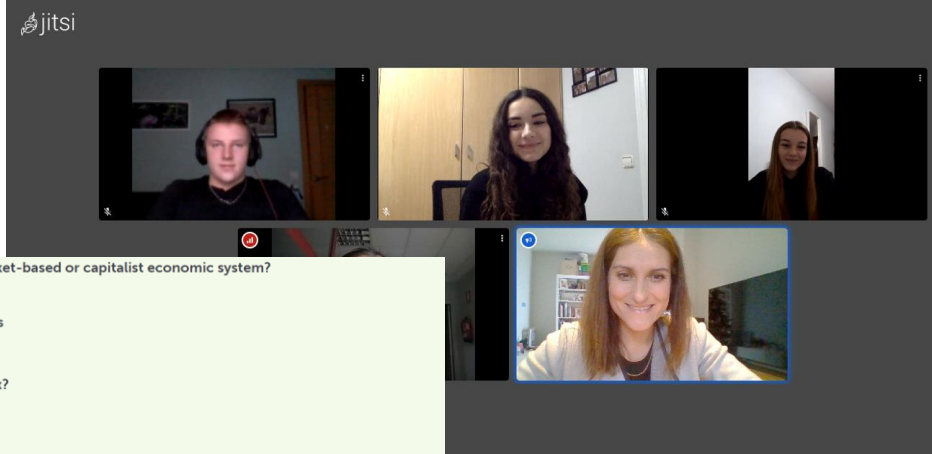


Interaktywna gra rywalizacyjna:

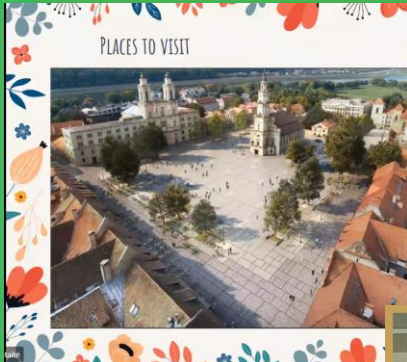
→ THE OLDEST TV PROGRAM STILL BEING BROADCASTED

- 1) The first event took place on May 24th 1956 in Switzerland, where only 7 countries participated.
- 2) Participants can't play instruments live, they have to be recorded.
- 3) Songs can't be more than 3 minutes long.
- 4) The number of performers on stage can't be more than 6.
- 5) Eurovision Song Contest always begins with the fanfare "Prieš du Teksčius" composed by Marc-Antoine Charpentier.
- 6) In 1975, four countries won Eurovision! UK, SPAIN, FRANCE and the NETHERLANDS all picked up the same score.

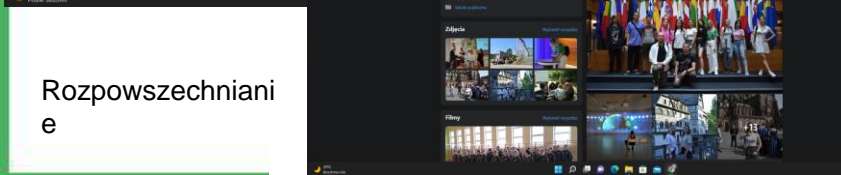
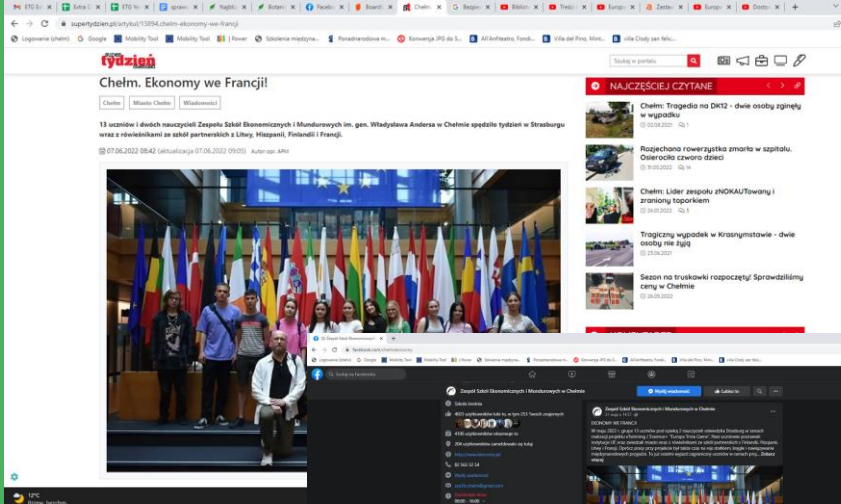
Erasmus+ project 'Europa Trivia Game' virtual meeting
