The ESEP platform (The European School Education Platform) is an online hub which allows all the verified eTwinners to network, search for partners, work on projects and seek professional development.





The profile helps other eTwinners to learn more about you – your interests, country of work, organisation (school), experience in eTwinning, project availability, etc.

The Idiom Mystery

The Idiom Mystery is an international eTwinning project for young learners (elementary school students in grades 1-3) to explore the fascinating world of English idioms. Working together with classmates from different countries, students will create a digital dictionary of English idioms creating visual representations, such as "a bird in the hand is worth two in the bush" or "to be a piece of cake" and a series of videos showcasing the meaning of idioms. Teachers will collaborate to develop interactive activities such as crossword puzzles, memory games, and bingo, to enhance students' understanding and engagement with the idioms as well as online quizzes and games to test students' idiomatic knowledge.

What is a good eTwinning project?

A good eTwinning project meets the following criteria:

Collaboration between partner schools:

- collaboration activities go beyond communication;
- partner schools work together to accomplish joint activities;
- partners are not just recipients of information;
- collaborative activities result in a tangible outcome.

Use of technology:

- the technology is used to help partners achieve their pedagogical objectives;
- the tools help partners to collaborate better among themselves.

Pedagogical approaches:

- the project has originality in terms of its theme;
- it uses a variety of pedagogical methods;
- pupils are the ones who take the lead;
- pupils interact with their partners and work collaboratively using different methods like information gathering, problem solving, research and comparative work;

What is a good eTwinning project?

A good eTwinning project meets the criteria:

Curricular integration:

- the project is rooted in the school curriculum and syllabi;
- the majority of project work is done during the school hours;
- the curricular integration in the project is clear;
- project work allows students develop their skills and competences;
- the project-based pedagogical framework has been explained and documented by the teacher.

Results and documentation

Make sure that:

- the project results are presented online;
- students are involved in the TwinSpace;
- all steps of the project are documented, including planning, descriptions of activities, evaluation and feedback;
- you evaluate and publish the impact that the project had on the students and teachers involved in the project;
- you use the checklist when planning and implementing your project to check if your project meets the QL criteria.



Project registration

Projects are only registered on the ESEP platform, in an eform.

You cannot register a project on your own – you always need a co-founder (an eTwinner from your own country or any other eTwinning country).

You need to select a school where you're planning to carry out the project (cannot be changed at a later stage).

You can only select a co-founder from your list of contacts.

After you submit the form, the co-founder needs to accept the invitation.

The project is pending until the NSO (and NSO of the cofounder) accepts it.

Both the founders receive an email once the project is accepted.

A tip! Prepare all the information/text you need for your registration form in a .doc file beforehand.

Students will put their digital and design skills to good use, creating word clouds, writing letters to Earth, making an e-dictionary as well as planning and celebrating Earth Day in their local communities. They will also sing a song for the planet.



Twinning Our project aims

- make young people aware of environmental problems
- increase students' ecological awareness through creative, interactive and interdisciplinary activities.
- stimulate students to find possible solutions to environmental problems
- develop interdisciplinary contents, promoting interdisciplinary activities.
- promote the ability to work in a team and improve the ability to act independently.
- improve decision making and problem solving through interaction with others.
- develop ICT and English language skills.
- develop collaborative and interpersonal skills.
- develop communication and critical thinking skills
- help teachers to network, learn how to run projects and make use of Twinspace functionalities

- Presentation of the project aims
- Introductions of students and teachers, project schools and countries
- Students make a project logo.
- Students make a word bank with vocabulary related to the environment and nature
- Students design dictionary entries using the vocabulary provided beforehand
- Teachers and students add dictionary entries to a common e-dictionary
- Teachers and students plan and organise school celebrations of Earth Day writing "A letter to our planet"
- Teachers and students add all the letters written by students to a common Wakelet collection
- Teachers and students all sing a song together "Sing for the climate" (Do it now)
- Evaluation

 develop digital content: word clouds, an e-dictionary, a collection, sing a song for the climate

Teachers:

- have better understanding of project management
- know how to use Twinspace
- make international connections with educators from abroad
- develop their IT skills

- develop their interpersonal and intrapersonal skills
- increase their linguistic abilities
