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eTwinning Quality Labels are granted to teachers with eTwinning projects which have reached a certain standard.



- The Quality Label is granted to a teacher and is personal.
- Each project member applies individually for a QL and presents how she/he has contributed to the project.
- The National Quality Labels are granted (by NSO) to the teachers who have contributed actively and visibly to the project's activities.



- 1. Your project is finished or is in its last phase.
- 2. The project has common goals and a shared plan, and your actions follow it.
- 3. All key results are published on TwinSpace pages (or at least there is a link to external sites through which the evaluators can access the content).
- Evidence of collaboration between partners, as well as the project results/outcomes are visible and clearly explained.
- 5. Your contribution is visible, especially in common results.
- Your project (and its main activities) has been evaluated and results (with conclusions) are published on project's TwinSpace.
- 7. You have taken into consideration the eSafety and copyright issues.



- 1. Pedagogical innovation
- 2. Curricular integration
- 3. Collaboration between partner schools
- 4. Use of technology
- 5. Results, impact and documentation

Don't forget to precisely describe your own contribution to the project. You can fill in the application form in your national language.



- Collaboration activities go beyond communication!
- The most important are:
- The aspects of the project where you and your partner(s) collaborated
- The activities in which pupils worked together
 - How were the final products of the project achieved by the pupils? Show not only the final result, but also the proces of planning, communication etc.

Read the evaluator's feedback carefully, ask your NSO, ask ambassadors – and try again!

Quality Label is a form of evaluation, not a competition



- It is awarded by the Central Support Organisation (CSO) to teachers in a project which:
- Has been proposed for the EQL by at least one NSO after a screening proces
 - Every NSO puts forward the top third of projects with NQL, based on their quality score
- Involves at least two partners who have received the NQL (in two different countries)
- The European Quality Label is awarded only once a year and is featured on the eTwinning Portal



- You can submit 4 projects per year for a QL
 - (submition period: 1st August 31st July)
- Only international projects are eligible
- Check with your National Support Organisation for additional deadlines!
